## **Knock-out competitions**

- 1. When signing up for a competition, players should check the playing dates to ensure that they are likely to be available to play the later rounds.
- 2. The top name on the draw is responsible for nominating dates to give to their opponent(s). (However this does not preclude the other person making contact).
- 3. Contact should be made as soon as the opponent(s) for the next round is known.
- 4. In a Pairs competition, partners should agree 3 dates between themselves before contacting their opponents.
- 5. The nominator/nominating team should offer at least 3 dates for the match. If none of these is acceptable, their opponent should offer an alternative 3 dates.
- 6. If a date is agreed and a team needs to cancel, then the opponent(s) should be given a bye into the next round (except in the case of the final when the matter will be referred to the Committee).
- 7. If it is impossible to arrive at an agreed date for the match, competitors should contact the Competition Secretary or the Captain a minimum of two weeks before the closing playing date so that the committee can adjudicate.
- 8. In the event of a dispute about availability, the number of games played at the Club over the year will influence the decision of the Committee.
- 9. If in the view of the Committee the case is totally impossible to resolve, the Committee will make a decision by the toss of a coin.
- 10.In only exceptional circumstances, e.g. course closure, will any extension be given.
